The Charity funds as of 31/3/2017 were reported as £366.45

“The charity has been operating over the past financial year in positive equity and in accordance with Charities Commission policies.

The fund is available to all residents of Garway parish who are aged 60 years and over. Anyone in this category is eligible, on application, for £30 per year for telephone or television licence or electricity expenses. The fund is restricted to one application per household annually.”
