## 4. To receive a report from The Frances Scudamore Charity

New trustees were appointed last year.

The charity has been operating over the past financial year in positive equity and in accordance with Charities Commission policies.

The fund is available to all young people aged 17 to 21 years currently undertaking academic or vocational education or training. An annual grant of £50 is available to each applicant over a maximum of four years, for assistance in purchasing equipment, tools, books and related course materials.

## 5. To receive a report from The Unknown Donors Charity

New trustees were appointed last year.

The charity has been operating over the past financial year in positive equity and in accordance with Charities Commission policies.

The fund is available to all residents of Garway parish who are aged 60 years and over. Anyone in this category is eligible, on application, for £30 per year for telephone or television licence or electricity expenses. The fund is restricted to one application per household annually.
